## **Time Obstacle Competition with two different round**

Table: acc. to Art. 971, with 2 different round. The second round can

be altered or shortened.

The second round is open to all drivers.

Both round will be carried out as time competitions (Art. 971.2), the penalty points will be converted into seconds. For

the placing the times of both round will be added.

Equipment: acc. to Art. 937 (Marathon harness)

The scale of penalties is as follows:	Penalty seconds
- Dislodging a ball in a single obstacle	5
- Knocking over or down any element of a Marathon type obstacle	5
- Causing an obstacle to be rebuilt (clock stops). The clock starts	
again when the Driver approaches the next obstacle.	10
- Groom (s) dismounting 1 <sup>st</sup> or 2 <sup>nd</sup> time (clock does not stop)	5 per incident
- Driver dismounting	20
- Groom uses the reins or the carriage wheel brakes	20
- Wrong course in a Marathon type obstacle, corrected	20
- Wrong gate (sequence or direction) with the entire turnout or	
part of the turnout, without dislodging an element (no clock stop)	20
- Wrong gate (sequence or direction) with part of the turnout and	35 in total per
dislodging an element (clock stops and obstacle is rebuilt)	incident
- Dislodging a ball from a wrong gate (sequence or direction)	
with a horse jumping into a cone, without passing through the	15 in total per
gate (clock stops and obstacle is rebuilt)	incident
- First or second disobedience	no penalties

## **Eliminations:**

Starting order:

- Groom(s) or driver dismounting 3 <sup>rd</sup> incident	elimination
- Third disobedience	elimination
- Wrong course, not corrected, in Marathon type obstacles	elimination
- Failing to pass through the starting or finishing flags	elimination
- Carriage turnover	elimination
- Active use of the whip by the groom	elimination

After ringing the bell the driver has 45 seconds to start his course; even if he has not started, the clock starts to run.

Obstacles: The indoor course consists of obstacles according to Art. 961

and 975.2.

- 2 marathon type obstacles (maximum 5 gates each)


- 1 bridge (optional)

#### COMPETITION No 12 Indoor Arena

Jump & Drive (Art. 970-981)

Open to: 8 drivers and 8 jumping riders **Athletes** 8 drivers from competition

**Riders** 8 riders will be selected by a draw from competition No 04.

Classification: The rider starts first and jumps a course of 8 obstacles.

After the last obstacle the rider enters a paddock, dismounts and gives the horse to the groom.

Afterwards the rider runs from the paddock to the Drivers'

waiting area and gets on the vehicle.

The driver must then drive an obstacle course with cones. The time is taken from the moment the rider crosses the starting line until the Athlete passes the finishing line. Table C, each obstacle penalty will be penalized with 4

seconds.

The elimination of either the rider or the Athlete incurs the

elimination of the whole team.

Vehicle: acc. to Art. 936 (marathon carriage)

Starting order: by draw

Total prize-money: € 3.000,--

Breakdown of prize-money: € 750,--, 600,--, 450,--, 300,--, 270,--, 210,--, 200,--

## **SPECIAL RULES AND CONDITIONS**

Entries which get in after the official entry date of January 21<sup>st</sup> 2016, can be only accepted, if there are still boxes avalable.

The Organiser reserves the right to do slight changes in the schedule of the time table in agreement with the Jury.

### **INSURANCE**

All owners and athletes are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

#### **LIABILITY**

The organizer declines any liability for property or pecuniary damage which may happen to visitors, athletes, grooms and horse owners through slight negligence of the organizer, his delegates or his assistants. The OC is liable in case of intent, gross negligence as well as in case of injury to life, body or health and in further cases he is liable for compelling legal liability acc. to the legal requirements. Furthermore he also declines any liability for theft, or other incidents.

#### DOGS

Outside the stable area, Dogs are only allowed on the leash.

#### **STABLES**

Horses may not be unloaded on their arrival without the authorization of the stable manager. The actual Equine Passport with the necessary vaccinations must be hand over to the stable manager. Stables will be allocated on arrival but please make special requests (e.g. stallions), with the definite entries.

Stables must be mucked out daily and dirty bedding and rubbish placed in the special containers.
